Renewal requirements

1. Completed registration form
2. Registration fees
3. Surety bond in your name (\$5,000 effective through the end of the year made out to Madison County Public Health) - Master Plumbers only
4. Copy of State of Ohio Plumbing Contractor's License – Master Plumbers only-or Commercial work being done
5. Cash, card, check, or money order payable to: **Madison County Public Health**

Registration fees

\$200 per master registration
\$50 per journeyman registration

Registration period

January 1st through December 31st of the current registration year.
Permits issued in December require registration for the following year.

Obtaining permits
