



Regions 1, 2 and 5 Meet Health Metrics to Enter Tier 2 Mitigations

The North, North-Central and Southern regions of Illinois can reenter Tier 2 mitigations **effective immediately.**

All other regions of the state are currently operating under Tier 3 mitigations.

Meetings and events	Groups limited to 25	Groups limited to 10	Paused
Offices	Open	Open	Remote work encouraged
Group recreation	Open	25 people max	Paused indoors, 10 person limit outdoors

Hundreds of Public Vaccination Sites Are Coming Online Across the State


In addition to local health department clinics, the state is making vaccines available at:

- Retail pharmacy chains
- Illinois National Guard mobile sites
- State-run mass vaccination clinics

- Hospitals and urgent care locations
- Doctors' offices
- Large employers

Residents in Phase 1A can get vaccinated at two state-driven sites in the coming days.

Phase 1B begins statewide with limited distribution on Monday, January 25.
