We hope that you had a good summer and wanted to alert you to some opportunities that are available for the upcoming academic year 2022 - 2023!

For In-School Youth:

This year we are able to offer our **WorkSMART** program for youth who are in school between the ages of 14 - 21 yrs. old living in Boston or Medford. Through the academic year program, you will be able to:

- Participate in an 8 Week Paid Internship for 10 hrs. per week
 - 1 week of work-readiness workshops to increase soft skills
 - 7 weeks at a partner worksite (8 hrs. per week) and Virtual Workshops (2hrs per week)
- Plus
 - Receive Guidance through weekly Mentoring sessions
 - Tutoring Support for Test Prep, including MCAS and/or SAT

For Out-of-School Youth:

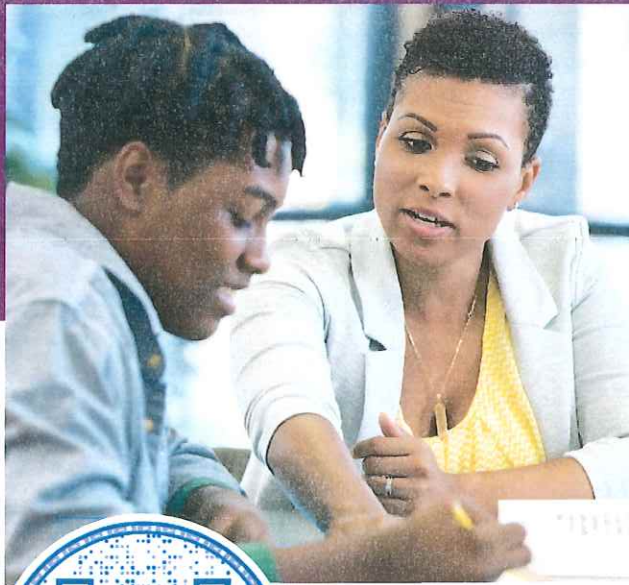
This year we have the following pathways available in our **Career Explorations** program for youth who are out-of-school (okay to be enrolled in a Hiset/GED program) between the ages of 18 - 24 yrs. old living in Boston: **Culinary Arts, Early Childhood Education, Human Services, Building Trades, ITS and Home Health Aide.**

Through the program, you will be able to:

- Participate in work-readiness workshops to increase soft skills;
- Enroll in industry specific training for 1 of the pathways listed above;
- Have a paid internship; and
- Receive case management/job search assistance.
