**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER
SCHEDULING CONTINUATION OF
AMENDED FAIRNESS AND FINAL
COMPLIANCE HEARING**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on September 6, 2022 via virtual hearing for an amended fairness and final compliance hearing regarding the Township of Mount Laurel; and the Township of Mount Laurel, being represented by counsel Linda A. Galella, Esq. (of Parker McCay P.A.), as well as Fair Share Housing Center, being represented by Laura Smith Denker; and Mary Beth Lonergan, P.P., A.I.C.P., Court-appointed Special Master also appearing; and the Court having verified that proper notice of the Hearing was published, posted and mailed and that jurisdiction to conduct the Hearing was properly vested in the Court; and no written comments or objections having been filed with the Court by interested parties by the deadline established in the Hearing Notice and

IT IS, on this 30th day of September, 2022, **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The amended fairness and final compliance hearing is hereby continued virtually until Tuesday, December 13, 2022 at 9 a.m.;
2. The Township shall provide to the Court Master crediting documents in its possession by September 30, 2022 and any additional crediting documents which it must gather by October 31, 2022;
3. By October 15, 2022, the Special Master shall review the first set of crediting documents and confirm with the Township and FSHC that they satisfactorily provide proper crediting documentation;
4. By November 15, 2022, the Special Master shall review the second set of crediting documents and confirm with the Township and FSHC that they satisfactorily provide proper crediting documentation;
5. By November 15, 2022, the Township shall prepare an administrative supplement to update the HEFSP information and place same on file with the Court;
6. By November 23, 2022, the Special Master shall confirm with the Township and FSHC that all outstanding conditions have been satisfied (with the exception of annual reporting requirements and other ongoing responsibilities detailed in its agreements with FSHC);
7. By December 6, 2022, the Special Master shall submit a report to the Court and parties as to her recommendation as to the fairness of the First Amendment to the Settlement Agreement with FSHC as well as to the Township's compliance.
8. Pursuant to paragraph 2 of the court's November 8, 2017 Conditional Declaratory Judgment of Compliance and Repose, and subject to compliance with the conditions of that Conditional Judgment, the Township shall continue to receive immunity and repose

against any and all Mount Laurel litigation and builder's remedy lawsuits until July 1, 2025.
