ORDINANCE 2020-1

CALENDAR YEAR 2020 MODEL ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45, et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Mount Laurel, in the County of Burlington finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2020 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$296,301.27 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Laurel, in the County of Burlington, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2020 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Mount Laurel shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$1,037,270.54, and that the CY 2020 municipal budget for the Township of Mount Laurel be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

ORDINANCE 2020-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT LAUREL, CHAPTER 148 ("VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC")

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT LAUREL, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Purpose and Intent. The amendment(s) set forth herein shall serve the purpose of establishing reasonable and impartial regulations with regard to vehicular traffic within the Township of Mount Laurel.

SECTION 2. Amendment(s). Chapter 148 ("Vehicles and Traffic"), Article XIV ("Schedules"), Section 148-37 ("Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections") shall be amended so as to include the following locations within the existing table:

Intersection	Stop sign on

SECTION 3. Repealer. Any and all other ordinances inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. Severability. In the event that any section paragraph, clause phrase, term, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such judgment shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, paragraph, clause, term, provision or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in such judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

Remington & Vernick Engineers performed an evaluation at the intersection of St. David Drive & St. David Drive located in the Township of Mount Laurel, Burlington County, New Jersey to determine if the existing conditions justify the installation of a STOP or YIELD sign at the northbound St. David Drive approach.

The study intersection was evaluated based upon criteria identified in the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways* (MUTCD) or in the New Jersey Statues Annotated Title 39 (N.J.S.A. Title 39).

The N.J.S.A. 39:4-197j permits the municipality to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and install appropriate signage on streets under municipal jurisdiction if the intersection is located within 500 feet of a school, playground or youth recreational facility and the street on which the STOP sign is installed is contiguous to that school, playground or youth recreational facility. A New Jersey professional engineer must certify the intersection is within 500 feet of a school, playground or youth recreational facility and that a school, playground or youth recreational facility is located along one of the intersecting streets. Documentation does not need to be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Transportation for review and concurrence. However, a municipal ordinance needs to be approved in order to enforce the STOP-controlled intersection.

The study intersection was reviewed to determine if a STOP sign is warranted at the St. David Drive approach. As indicated in the MUTCD, the use of STOP signs on the minor-street approaches should be considered if engineering judgment indicates a stop is always required because of one or more of the following conditions:

• The vehicular traffic volumes on the through street or highway exceed 6,000 vehicles per day;

- Crash records indicate three or more crashes that are susceptible to correction by the installation of a STOP sign have been reported within a 12-month period, or that five or more such crashes have been reported within a 2-year period. Such crashes include right-angle collisions involving road users on the minor-street approach failing to yield the right-of-way to traffic on the through street or highway; and/or
- A restricted view exists requiring road users to stop in order to adequately observe conflicting traffic on the through street or highway.

If a STOP sign is not warranted, then the installation of a YIELD sign should be considered. Based upon the MUTCD, a YIELD sign may be installed on the approaches to a through street where conditions are such that a full stop is not always required. The YIELD sign assigns right-of-way to traffic on certain approaches to an intersection. Vehicles controlled by a YIELD sign need to slow down to a speed reasonable for the existing conditions or stop when necessary to avoid interfering with conflicting traffic. Please note that the appropriate intersection sight distance must exist in order to recommend a YIELD-controlled intersection.




Figure 1 - Location Clear Sight Triangles

As indicated in the manual entitled A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets, 6th Edition (2011) published by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) "drivers approaching YIELD signs are permitted to enter the (intersecting) major road without stopping, if there are no potential conflicting vehicles on the major road. The sight distance needed by drivers on yield-controlled approaches exceed those for stop-controlled approaches." The configuration and size of the clear sight triangle required for yield-controlled approaches is indicated in Figure 1 and Table 1, respectively. If the clear sight triangles are not available at an intersection, a STOP sign is warranted.

Based on our review at the study intersection, clear sight triangles for a 25-mile-per-hour speed limit as required by AASHTO do not exist at the northbound St. David Drive approach to warrant a Yield-controlled intersection.

Therefore, a STOP controlled intersection is warranted at St. David Drive & St. David Drive and we recommend that a STOP sign be installed at the northbound St. David Drive approach to the intersection as shown the attached sketch. A municipal ordinance will have to be adopted to enforce the STOP condition at this intersection.

This recommendation is based on our investigation and is in the interest of safety and the expedition of traffic on the public highways.
