MOUNT LAUREL TOWNSHIP RECOGNIZES HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH

Mount Laurel, NJ --- On Monday September 12, Mount Laurel Township adopted a proclamation recognizing Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15 – October 15.

This month honors the many accomplishments and contributions of Hispanic Americans to our society's culture and history. The anniversary of independence for countries including Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua all fall on September 15.

Hispanic Heritage Month provides an opportunity to reaffirm Mount Laurel Township's commitment in our support for the Hispanic American community.

“Our Mount Laurel community is made stronger when we recognize and celebrate our diverse communities. Hispanic Americans influence all aspects of American culture- from the food we eat, the music we listen to, and businesses we shop. Let this month recognize that our diversity makes us unique,” stated Mayor Pritchett.

Deputy Mayor Steglik said, “To recognize the importance of Hispanic Americans as an integral part of our community here in Mount Laurel for the first time is something Township Council was looking forward to doing.”

The resolution took effect immediately after adoption.
