MILLING AND PAVING TO BEGIN ON MOUNT LAUREL ROAD

Mount Laurel, NJ --- Starting on Friday, September 24th milling and paving will begin to three sections on Mount Laurel Road. Southbound traffic will be affected and there will be detours in place.

The project will start at 8:30 am and will conclude at 4:30pm. Northbound traffic will flow as normal. Detours will be in place for southbound traffic.

Three police officers will be on location to guide traffic. Residents will maintain access to the Board of Education and the Bus Parking Lot, as well as from Mount Laurel Road northbound at Hainesport Road.

The project will be conducted in three phases. Phase One will start at Mount Laurel Road/Tara Drive. A detour will be placed at Elbo Lane, and vehicles will proceed to Hartford Road, to Church Road, and back to Mount Laurel Road.

Phase Two will start at Mount Laurel Road near Eric's Lawn Care. A detour will be placed at Hainesport Road, vehicles will then proceed to Elbo Lane and back to Mount Laurel Road.

Phase Three will begin at Mount Laurel Road/north of Hainesport Rd. A detour will be placed at Union Mill Road, vehicles will then proceed to Elbo Lane and back to Mount Laurel Road.
