

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEW BERN, NORTH CAROLINA, ADOPTING THE REGIONAL CAMA LAND USE PLAN

WHEREAS, New Bern, River Bend, and Trent Woods have conducted a series of public workshops and meetings as part of a comprehensive public participation program and drafted an update to the New Bern Regional CAMA Land Use Plan based on the community feedback and with the oversight of an Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of River Bend and Trent Woods have adopted the draft CAMA Land Use Plan; and

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2010, the New Bern Planning Board recommended adoption of the draft CAMA Land Use Plan; and


WHEREAS, the draft CAMA Land Use Plan has been available for public review in the Planning and Inspections office and on the City of New Bern's website; and
