


Is there a need for a playground designed especially for the physically and sensory challenged (a.k.a. boundless playground)?

I like the family movies, but I would like family movies that aren't all cartoons. Also need better advertising, I have missed some not knowing when they were.

Make an effort to get a minor baseball team class A into New Bern, a stadium like Kinston's' facility. We have plenty of property in and around New Bern.

I would like to see SAFE bicycling paths connecting parks and areas of lower traffic. Paths should be WIDE enough to accommodate adult tricycles with baskets for shopping and secure stations to lock them up. Many cycle handlebars are wider than the bicycle areas we have.

I would like to see small shelters at Union Park.

All of the parks need bathrooms, soda machines, and healthy snack bars so more people can enjoy the parks. After you have rested you can purchase something to dring, use the restroom, or get a quick snack. All must be clean!

We are fortunate to have them and to have such variety. For the most part they are well maintained, although litter is always a problem (as it is in the city itself). Don Miller Park has deteriorated very seriously. Originally intended for community water access it is now a dangerous area in which drug activity and homeless individuals are frequent sights. Condom wrappers, cigarettes, liquor bottles reappear as soon as neighborhood volunteers pick up the trash, which we do weekly.
