

City of New Bern Honor Tree Program



What is the Honor Tree Program?

This program provides an opportunity for someone to pay tribute to a current or former city resident (living or deceased) by dedicating an existing tree in a city park or green space in their honor or memory. Individuals or groups who have made a significant contribution to our City, County, or Country can be honored.

Where are the Trees located?

Honor Trees are available at any City of New Bern Park or green space. Trees that are included in the program are existing mature trees in city parks and green spaces. Existing trees are used rather than newly planted trees to ensure their viability as a living tribute that will last for years to come.

How much does an Honor Tree cost?

The cost for an Honor Tree is **\$300.00** for **City Residents and \$350.00** for **non Residents.** A memorial stone (5" x 10", gray) can be purchased separately. These stones are available through Neuse Memorials. The inscription can hold up to 25 characters on three lines. For additional information, please call New Bern Parks & Recreation at 252-639-2901.
