Hours: DAWN to DUSK Daily  
(Unless otherwise posted)

**ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK!**

**This park is a natural wildlife habitat. Wildlife is present. Please be aware of biting insects, reptiles, wild animals, and poisonous plants that inhabit this area. Please stay on the existing trails and watch out for uneven surfaces or any loose terrain you may encounter. As a courtesy to all visitors, bikers are to yield to all pedestrians. A permit is required for any special events that are held at this park.**

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Park hours are posted at the entrance.
2. Park gates close at times designated on the entrance.
3. Those within the park after hours will be considered Trespassing.
4. Only authorized vehicles are allowed past designated gates. Other vehicles shall be considered Trespassing.
5. Bank fishing is allowed in the main lake and island lake only.
6. Children should not enter without adult supervision.
7. All pets must be on a leash, under control of the owner. Please clean up after your pet.
8. The following activities are prohibited:

- Alcohol or drugs.
- Camping.
- Fires
- Glass containers.
- Horseback riding.
- Hunting or Weapons.
- Littering.
- Off road vehicles (ATV's, Dirt bikes, etc...)
- SWIMMING.

9. Small boats (canoes/kayaks) may be used on the main lake and island lake. Launch at your own risk at designated launch areas. Underwater hazards exist. No gas motors.
10. Do not attempt to touch, befriend, feed, or help any wild animal you encounter while on the property.
11. The City of New Bern assumes NO RESPONSIBILITY for damaged, lost or stolen articles.
12. Failure to follow these rules and regulations shall result in ejection from the park.
