#### WHO IS DEVELOPING THE PROJECT?

The City of New Bern Department of Parks and Recreation is managing the project. New Bern Parks and Recreation has contracted with the Architecture/Engineering Firm, CPL, to lead Public Involvement and Design of the new facility. The Board of Alderman has appointed the Stanley White Recreation Center Advisory Committee to advise the design Team during project development.

#### CONSTRAINTS AND OPPORTUNITIES

If rebuilding in existing location, FEMA conditions state:

- Existing location is in a flood plain
- Footprint may not be expanded (18,057 sf)
- FEMA promotes relocation outside of floodplain for long-term resiliency

The City of New Bern has \$8,006,649.05 in fully allocated and committed funds for this project.

\$5,629,986.75 FEMA reimbursement \$500,000 Insurance reimbursement

\$1,876,662.30 State (NC) funds







#### WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE FOR THIS PROJECT?
