Overview

The City of Northglenn was incorporated in 1969, growing from the Perl-Mack subdivision dubbed “the most perfectly planned community in America” by Life Magazine and the National Association of Home Builders in 1961. Today, Northglenn covers 7.5 square miles and is home to about 39,000 residents and 1,000 businesses.

The City provides municipal services like public safety, public works, water, trash, recycling, neighborhood services, support for local businesses, planning, parks, recreation, and cultural arts.

Our close-knit community offers a variety of vibrant neighborhoods, wonderful parks and trails, and numerous free community events. The Northglenn Recreation Center, Senior Center, and Theatre provides a broad range of programming and performances for all ages.

Other City facilities include City Hall, Justice Center, Maintenance & Operations Facility, Water Treatment Facility and Wastewater Treatment Plant.

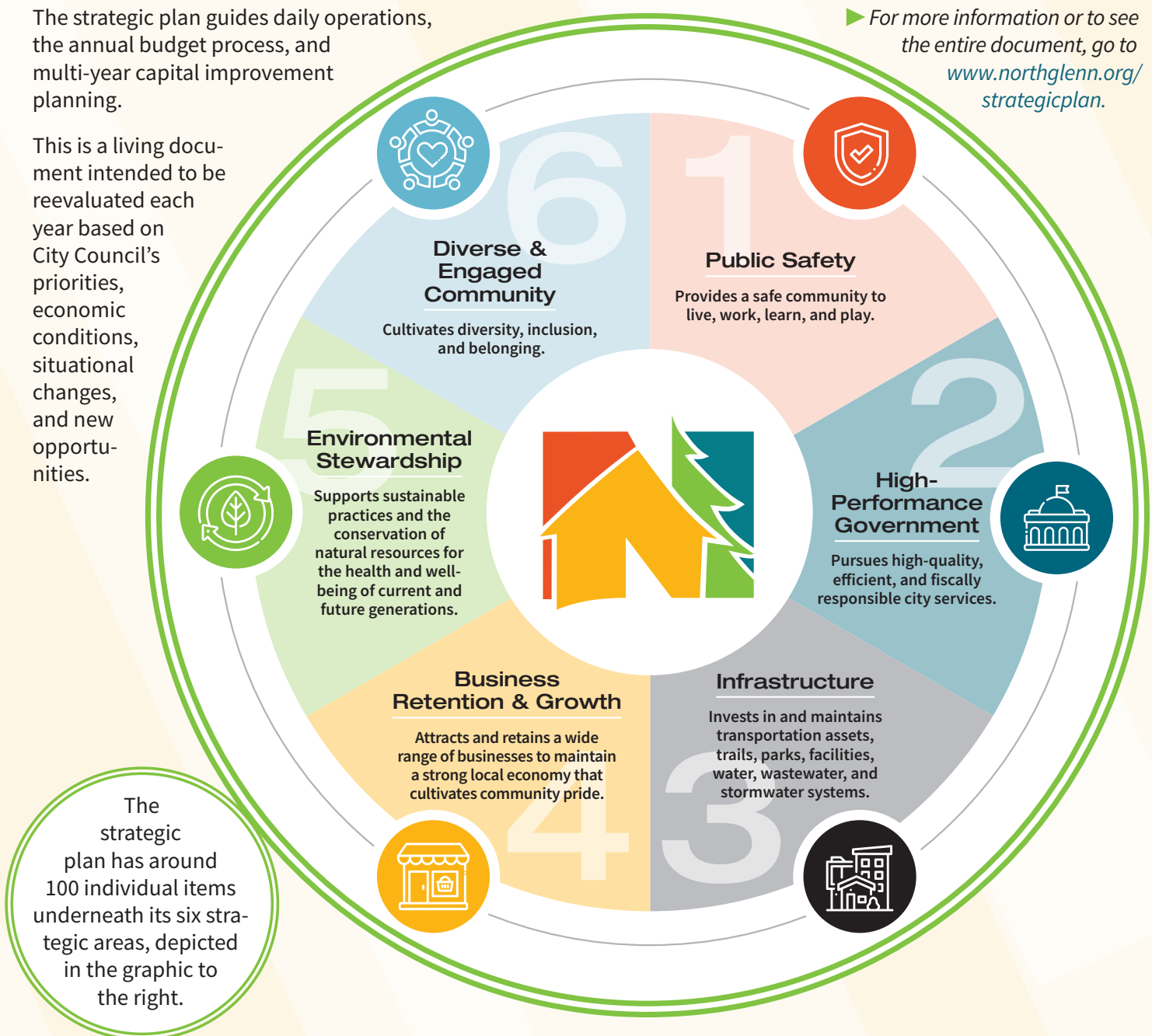

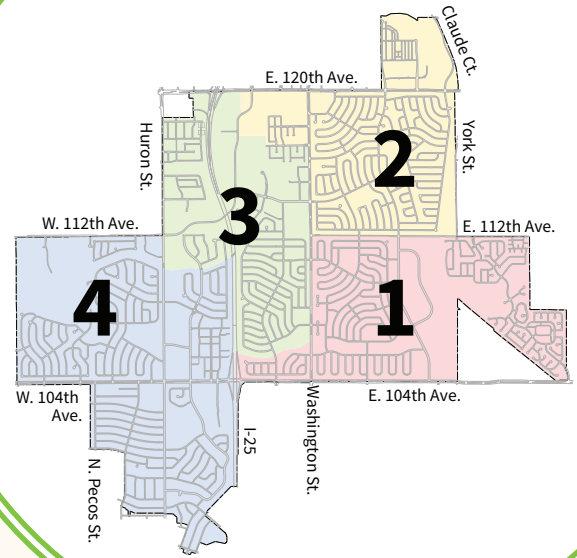


City Leadership

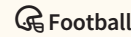

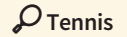
