ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 22-02*

Subject: VACATING Admin Order 20-06

**This order vacated Administrative Order 20-06 Detention and Execution of Northglenn Municipal Arrest Warrants.*

On May 28, 2020 the Adams County Detention Facility (ACDF) issued Current Guidelines for New Arrests. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic the ACDF is not accepting municipal arrest warrants unless it is a Victim Rights Act crime.

In response to law enforcement's inability to execute municipal arrest warrants and detain persons with municipal arrest warrants the Northglenn Municipal Court converted all secure (cash or surety) bonds for non-Victim Rights Act crime to an unsecured personal recognizance bond with no other conditions returnable to the Northglenn Municipal Court.

The ACDF is now accepting municipal warrants, as such, Administrative Order 20-06 Detention and Execution of Northglenn Municipal Arrest Warrants is no longer necessary. Therefore, **Administrative Order 20-06 Detention and Execution of Northglenn Municipal Arrest Warrants is VACATED.**

When a Defendant is detained on a bench warrant which requires the Defendant post a secure bond, the Defendant must be detained and taken into custody. The Defendant must post bond or wait for a bond hearing which will be held within "two calendar days, excluding Sundays and federal holidays." Colo. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 13-10-111.5(2). If a bond hearing cannot be held within the statutory time frames pursuant to Colo. Rev. Stat. Ann. § 13-10-111.5 (5) the Defendant shall be released on a personal recognizance bond with no other conditions.
