UPDATE - Dog returned to owner safely

(Northglenn, CO) On December 27, 2018 at approximately 10:57 p.m. officers of the Northglenn Police Department were dispatched to the 300 block of W. 104th Avenue on the report of an aggravated robbery. When officers arrived, they spoke to the victim who told them he had been robbed at gunpoint by three men. The victim told officers the suspects took his wallet and other personal items. He said they also took his dog Rose. Rose is a Corgi-Border Collie mix and her photo is included.

The suspects were described as being 25 to 35 years of age. Two of the men were described as African-American wearing all black clothing. The third suspect was described as a white male with short hair and a short beard. The victim said the suspects were in a black Lincoln Navigator. There is no further suspect information at this time.
