(Northglenn, CO) On July 28, 2019, at approximately 10 p.m. officers of the Northglenn Police Department were southbound on Grant Drive when they heard what was believed to be shots fired.

When officers arrived at Grant Drive and Garland Drive they were approached by a male stating that he was shot at and the two suspects, who were on a motorcycle, went eastbound on Garland Drive. As officers approached the intersection of Garland Drive and Washington Street they located the two suspects who then attempted to get back onto a motorcycle. One suspect was able to flee at a high rate of speed while the other suspect, 47-year-old Eric Flynn, was detained.

Additional officers responded to Grant Drive and Garland Drive to speak to the male who was originally contacted. The male stated that he was following two motorcycles, one of which he owned, that was stolen earlier from 11625 Community Center Drive. The male further advised that he turned his vehicle in front of the motorcycle that he owned, the motorcycle went down, and subsequent shots were fired at him in his vehicle before the two suspects fled on the other motorcycle.
