(Northglenn, CO) On August 17, at approximately 7:45 a.m. officers of the Northglenn Police Department responded to a multiple vehicle accident at the intersection of 112th Ave. and Huron St. in which a red 2007 Honda Civic fled the scene.

During the investigation officers learned that the Honda Civic involved in the accident was carjacked from 11310 Melody Dr. just prior to the crash.

Officers spoke with the owner of the Honda Civic who stated he was approached by a Hispanic male in his late teens or early 20's, approximately 5'10, 200 lbs., who displayed a knife and demanded the keys. The suspect was further described as wearing a white t-shirt, dark pants, with short "frizzy" hair, and a short mustache and goatee.

Officers located the Honda Civic abandoned at 9595 Pecos St. A search of the area was conducted but no suspect was located.

There were no injuries to the owner of the Honda Civic and minor injury to one person involved in the accident.
