(Northglenn, CO) On November 3, at approximately 3:30 a.m., officers of the Northglenn Police Department responded to a convenience store located in the 11400 block of Washington Street reference a robbery that had just occurred. Upon arrival, officers learned that two male suspects entered the store and demanded the store clerk open the cash register. One of the male suspects was armed with a handgun and the other male suspect was armed with a knife. Before the store clerk opened the register, the clerk was struck in the head by one of the suspects, causing minor injury. The suspects took money from the register and fled southbound on foot. One of the suspects was described as a male, wearing a red hoodie with the hood up, a front-facing baseball cap with a red bill, jeans, black shoes, and a black and white face covering. This suspect was carrying a black backpack and he was armed with a knife. The other suspect was described as a male, wearing a black hooded jacket with the hood up, black pants, red shoes, and a face mask. This suspect was armed with a handgun. This incident is currently under investigation by the Northglenn Police Department.
