**INVESTIGATIVE UPDATE: Original Press Release 22-12 / CR# 22-6898
11600 block of Pearl St.**

On October 2, two male juveniles broke a fence to gain entry into the backyard and garage-like structure attached to a home in the 11600 block of Pearl St. One juvenile was in possession of a semi-automatic handgun and one with a machete; both weapons were recovered from the scene. One of the juveniles and the resident of the home exchanged gunfire.

Both juveniles were transported to the local hospital by medical, and later died. Next of kin notifications have been made. However, the names are not being released. The resident of the home was uninjured.

Items from a linked burglary, including an airsoft gun, were subsequently recovered in the backyard of the Pearl St. residence. The airsoft gun was not a factor in the shooting.

Once the investigation is complete, the Northglenn Police Department will formally present the results of the investigation to the District Attorney's Office and the District Attorney will make a determination on whether the facts of the case warrant criminal charges.
