# Automated Trash Collection Regulations

Effective 10/1/2018

*The following is a summary of regulations regarding trash collection by the City of Northglenn for single family homes. Understanding these regulations will help all homeowners benefit from this City service.*

## **COLLECTION TIME:**

Trash carts or special pick-up items shall be placed for collection **no later than 7 a.m.** on the day of collection, and can be set out no earlier than 5 p.m. on the day prior to collection.

## **PLACEMENT OF TRASH CARTS:**

Place trash cart in the gutter with the wheels and handle facing towards the residence. If you have more than one trash cart they should be no closer than two (2) feet from each other and no closer than six (6) feet from parked vehicle.

**Please do not place trash cart on the sidewalk.**

## **CONTAINMENT OF TRASH ITEMS:**

- 1) Cold ashes or pet feces should be placed in a sealed double bag when placed in the trash cart.
- 2) Sod or soil will be collected if it does not, when combined with other materials, exceed the weight capacity of the trash cart.

## **MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED:**

- 1) Trash which is not contained within trash cart.
- 2) Trash in any non-city purchased trash cart.
- 3) Paint in liquid form, chemicals, biological or medical waste or medicines.
- 4) Dead animals or parts of animals.
- 5) Hot ashes or coals.
- 6) Electronic waste (TV's, DVD/VCR equipment, computers and peripherals, video game consoles, radios, stereos, etc.)

## **LIMITATIONS:**

The maximum trash volume collected at any one regular weekly pick up is limited to no more than three (3) approved trash carts.

## **HOLIDAYS OBSERVED:**

Trash will not be collected on the following holidays:

**Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Year's Day**

If your trash collection day falls on one of those days, it will be picked up on the next business day following the holiday.

## **OIL, ANTIFREEZE & BATTERY RECYCLING:**

Motor, gear, transmission oil, and antifreeze can be set out next to your trash carts each week on your trash day. They must be contained in separate clear one (1) gallon non-leaking containers, clearly indicating the contents and your name and address. Limit five (5) gallons per week.

Two (2) automotive batteries may be set out next to your trash cart each week on your pick up day.

## **SPECIAL PICK-UPS:**

You may have two (2) Special Pick-ups per calendar year.

Up to ten (10) bulky household items such as furniture, appliances, and exercise equipment can be picked up on your trash day by appointment only. Please call the Special Pick-up line at **303.450.4004** to schedule.

Appliances with Freon, boxes, bagged trash, yard waste, construction materials, electronics, carpeting/rugs, hot tubs, sheds, pianos/organs, camper shells cannot be picked up.

**You must call no later than 2:30 p.m. one business day prior to your collection day.**

**Please note:** Tires and mattresses/boxsprings will be charged an additional fee for pick up. See Special Services Fee Schedule for charges.

## **SPECIAL SERVICES FEE SCHEDULE:**

**Special Pick-ups:** Two (2) Special Pick-ups are allowed per calendar year. Additional Special Pick-ups will be charged \$100.00.

**Appliances:** One (1) of each type of major appliance can be picked up each calendar year. Pick up of a second same type of appliance will incur a \$65 charge. NOTE: Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners are not picked up.

**Tires:** In accordance with Federal regulations, the City charges \$2 each for passenger car, light truck and motorcycle tires; \$5 each for truck tires. All tires must be removed from rims.

**Mattresses/Boxsprings:** \$65 charge to pick up 1-2 pieces. \$20 for each additional piece.

**Special Services: \$10.00 for trash service on non-regular trash collection days.**

**Roll-off Rental:** \$257.00 for a weekday rental (Monday delivery, Thursday pick up), or weekend rental (Friday delivery, Monday pick-up).

## **Neighborhood Clean Up Roll-off Request:**

Groups of 5 residences in the same immediate area can request to share a roll-off at no charge. Go to [northglenn.org/rolloff](http://northglenn.org/rolloff) for details and to apply on-line.

## **NOTICE OF VIOLATION:**

Trash that is in violation of these regulations will not be collected, and a **Courtesy Notice** will be left stating the reason.
