Automated Trash Collection Regulations

Effective 7/1/2018

The following is a summary of regulations regarding trash collection by the City of Northglenn for single family homes. Understanding these regulations will help all homeowners benefit from this City service.

COLLECTION TIME:

Carts for trash collection or any special pick-up items shall be placed for collection **no later than 7:00 a.m.** on the day of collection, or after 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to collection.

PLACEMENT OF TRASH CARTS:

Place trash cart in the gutter with the wheels and handle facing towards the residence. If you have more than one trash cart they should be no closer than two (2) feet from each other and no closer than six (6) feet from parked vehicle.

Please do not place trash cart on the sidewalk.

CONTAINMENT OF TRASH ITEMS:

- 1) Cold ashes or pet feces should be placed in a sealed double bag when placed in the trash cart.
- 2) Sod or soil will be collected if it does not, when combined with other materials, exceed the weight capacity of the polycart.

MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED:

- 1) Trash which is not contained within trash cart.
- 2) Trash in any non-city purchased trash cart.
- 3) Paint in liquid form, chemicals, biological or medical waste or medicines.
- 4) Dead animals or parts of animals.
- 5) Hot ashes or coals.
- 6) Electronic Waste (TV's, DVD/VCR equipment, computers and peripherals, video game consoles, radios, stereos, etc.)

LIMITATIONS:

The maximum trash volume collected at any one regular weekly pick-up shall be limited to no more than three (3) approved trash containers.

HOLIDAYS OBSERVED:

Trash will not be collected on the following holidays:

Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

If your trash collection day falls on one of those days, it will be picked up on the next business day following the holiday.

OIL, ANTIFREEZE & BATTERY RECYCLING:

Motor, gear, transmission oil and antifreeze can be set out next to your trash containers each week on your trash day. They must be contained in a separate clear one gallon non-leaking container, clearly indicating the contents and your name and address. Limit 5 gallons per week.

Two (2) automotive batteries may be set out next to your trash container each week on your pick-up day.

SPECIAL PICK-UPS:

Up to 10 bulk items such as appliances, furniture and exercise equipment can be picked up on your regular trash day by appointment only. Please call the Special Pick-up line at **(303) 450-4004** to schedule.

Appliances with Freon, mattresses or boxsprings, boxes, bagged trash, yard waste, construction materials, electronics, carpeting/rugs, hot tubs, sheds, pianos/organs, camper shells cannot be picked up on a Special Pick-Up.

You must call no later than 2:30 p.m. one business day prior to your collection day.

You may have two free Special Pick-ups per calendar year. You may have up to ten items per pickup.

Please note: Tires will be charged an additional fee for pickup. See Special Services Fee Schedule for charges.

SPECIAL SERVICES FEE SCHEDULE:

Special Pick-ups: Two free Special Pick-ups per calendar year. Additional Special Pick-ups will be charged \$100.00.

Appliances: This special pick-up service is limited to one of each major type of appliance per calendar year. Additional appliances collected above this limit are charged \$65.00 each. Note: Freon charged appliances are not picked up.

Roll-off Rental: \$257.00 for 3-day weekday rental (Monday delivery, Thursday pick-up), or 3-day weekend rental (Friday delivery, Monday pick-up).

Neighborhood Clean Up Roll-off Request:

Groups of 5 residences in the same immediate area can request to share a roll-off at no charge. Go to www.northglenn.org/rolloff for details and on-line application.

Tires: In accordance with Federal regulations, the City charges \$2.00 each for passenger car, light truck, and motorcycle tires; \$5.00 each for truck tires. All tires must be removed from rims.

Special Services: \$10.00 for trash service on non-regular trash collection days.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION:

Trash that is in violation of these regulations will not be collected and a **Violation Notice** will be left stating the reason.
