**1. Storm Water/Infrastructure Maintenance Monthly Report**

Mayor stated, maintenance reports to Cedar Estates Regional basin, he is waiting on Sewer District signed agreement for the community cost share funds that Council approved on January 7, 2020. Once they receive it, the City will contact DiGioia Suburban to get a schedule of when they can do the work. The other issue is the Biro Ditch, the authorization letters have been sent out so that we can utilize the contractor to clean up between Albion and York and Cinnamon Lakes. When Mark gets back tomorrow, I will see how that has gone so far, as far as the letters that have gone out, what we have received back and what we still need to do.

Councilman Langshaw stated, City Engineer Mark SchSchmitzer and I talked before he left, if there are still remaining ones out, I am willing to even knock on doors. I know I keep getting contacted by residents. Mayor stated, hopefully people will sign them. Councilman Langshaw stated, I will throw on a jacket, boots and knock on some doors. Thank you, Mr. Mayor.

Mayor stated, the stormwater infrastructure maintenance, Nick did you have anything on that? Nick Cinquepalmi, just that right now at this time of year it is pretty much like a night like this or day like this, it rains, there is still leaves out and we go around, we make sure that things are open. As far as the projects there is nothing really going on right now.

**2. Maintenance Projects**

- a.** Cedar Estates Regional Basin – Waiting on NEORSD’s signed agreement for Community Cost Share funds that Council approved on 1/7/2020. Once received, City will contact DiGioia Suburban to get a schedule of when they can do the work.
- b.** Biro Ditch – authorization letters being sent out so City can utilize contractor to clean between Albion/York and Cinnamon Lakes

**3. Turnpike Mitigation**

York Road Drainage – working with ODOT to finalize plans; still on track for July 2020 construction.

Mayor stated the project there is the York Road drainage, Mark is working with ODOT to finalize the plans and it is still on track for a July 2020 construction.
