

The bid opening for the City of North Royalton Cemetery Receiving Vault Repairs occurred on Thursday, March 5, 2020 at 12:00pm at City Hall. The following page contains the resultant summary of the bids submitted. It should be noted that the bid of Mid State Restoration Inc. did not qualify as a complete bid as it was missing a signed Non-Collusion Affidavit, Property Tax Affidavit and a Campaign Finance Letter. In discussions with the Law Director, it was determined that this bid was not responsive and therefore not considered as a complete bid.

After extensive review of the submitted bids, the Engineering Department (through the architect of record Perspectus Architecture) recommends <u>Grunwell-Cashero Co.</u>, who is qualified to perform the work, the award of the lowest and best bid amount (including all alternates) of **\$61,600.00**.

Attached to this Memorandum is the <u>complete</u> Official Bid Tabulation for the City of North Royalton Cemetery Receiving Vault Repairs, as well as a letter of recommendation from Perspectus Architecture who qualified the bids.

Perspectus Historic Architecture is pleased with the number of qualified contractors that presented bids for the Receiving Vault Repairs. We have reviewed the three complete bids, including the qualifications statements. All firms appear to be qualified. We have had previous experience with two of the bidders, Grunwell-Cashero and Quality Masonry. Our experience with both firms has been positive. Attached is the Tabulation of Bids.

The lowest qualified bid was Grunwell-Cashero Co of Cleveland, Ohio at \$61,600, If all alternates are accepted.

All of the bids received were lower than our estimate for the project. We have contacted Grunwell-Cashero and asked them to review their bid. This is normal protocol, when bids are significantly lower than the estimate. The contractor is typically given the opportunity to review the bid, with the option to withdraw if they made an error. Frank Caspio of Grunwell-Cashero has stated that he has reviewed the bid and has stated that the bid price reflects the complete project, without error or omission, in accordance with the contract documents.

Perspectus Historic Architecture takes no exception to the submitted bid or qualifications and recommends that the City accept all alternates for the project along with the base bid provided by Grunwell-Cashero.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2020 RAM 2500 TRADESMAN CREW CAB 4X4 FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$29,794.00, VENDOR MEDINA AUTO MALL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of one (1) motor vehicle for the North Royalton Recreation Department; and
- The city is purchasing this vehicle and equipment through Medina Auto Mall which meets or WHEREAS: exceeds the specifications of the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as required by House Bill 204; and
- WHEREAS: It is necessary to provide for the funding of said purchase.





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, PART 4 TRAFFIC CODE, TITLE SIX, CHAPTER 432 OPERATION GENERALLY, SECTION 432.30 STOPPING FOR SCHOOL BUS; ACTUATING VISUAL SIGNALS; DISCHARGING CHILDREN, PARAGRAPH (f)(1), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- <u>WHEREAS</u>: In an effort to enhance the protection for and the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of North Royalton, in particular school children, it has been determined to be necessary to increase the penalty associated with "failing to stop for a school bus" in the city; and
- <u>WHEREAS</u>: It is of singular importance to ensure all school children are able to travel to and from school safely; and
- <u>WHEREAS</u>: It is therefore necessary to amend Part 4 Traffic Code, Title Six, Chapter 432 Operation Generally, Section 432.30 Stopping for School Bus; Actuating Visual Signals; Discharging Children, Paragraph (f)(1) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton concerning fines for "failing to stop for school bus" when receiving or discharging school children; and
- <u>WHEREAS</u>: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> Part 4 Traffic Code, Title Six, Chapter 432 Operation Generally, Section 432.30 Stopping for School Bus; Actuating Visual Signals; Discharging Children, Paragraph (f)(1) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton be and is hereby amended as follows:

432.30 STOPPING FOR SCHOOL BUS; ACTUATING VISUAL SIGNALS; DISCHARGING CHILDREN

(f) (1) Whoever violates division (a) of this section may be fined an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) *One thousand dollars* (\$1000.00). A person who is issued a citation for a violation of division (a) of this section is not permitted to enter a written plea of guilty and waive the person's right to contest the citation in a trial but instead must appear in person in the proper court to answer the charge.

<u>Section 2</u>. Section 432.30 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Chapter 432 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

<u>Section 4</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Part 4 Traffic Code, Title Six, Chapter 432 Operation Generally, Section 432.30 Stopping for School Bus; Actuating Visual Signals; Discharging Children, Paragraph (f)(1)of the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton to increase the fine for failure to stop for school buses receiving or discharging school children.
