APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. **Updates on sidewalks and connections**

Mr. Schmitzer states we are still working on the plans for the Bennett Road pathways and State Road sidewalk. The survey is just getting completed for the State Road sidewalk portion, filling out all the forms for ODOT, we should have plans submitted to them in December. We are still on schedule for 2021 construction. Both projects will be bid out at the same time.

2. **Service Department Report**

5. **2020 Road Maintenance Program**

Mayor states we are finishing up in Timber Lane, been doing a little bit of asphalt work.

Mr. Weimer states we started looking at Bennett this week to find out why the basins are failing. It is going to go out for bid at some point. They know what the problem is now, we can hopefully get Bennett Road fixed so, we don't have all the issues that we are having right now with that concrete area.

6. **2020 Road Program**

Mr. Schmitzer states that we are done. We got the final invoice yesterday, we are reconciling all of our costs, and see how much money we saved.

Mr. Weimer states Mr. Mayor I know that you gave us a list of what roads that we were thinking about doing as part of the road program, is there a way we can get emailed to us a comparison of what we actually did on that list versus what is still left. I know we cut some stuff because of COVID-19.

Mayor states most of the stuff that we cut was mostly on the concrete program. We did the asphalt roads that we had planned. We just got awarded a 50/50 program for Abbey Road.

Mr. Schmitzer states so the County's 50/50 program allows anyone with the County to apply for road money. They will cover 50% of the cost up to a maximum of \$250,000.00 on a roadway resurfacing project. We applied for Abbey Road for the last couple of years, and last year we also applied for Akins Road from State all the way to Broadview Road. We are working with Broadview Heights on that, we figured two entities brought together might give us better scoring on it; we didn't get it, but the good thing is if we got it for Akins, we had an agreement with Broadview Heights to split it, so we both saw a \$125,000.00 savings. Now we are seeing a full \$250,000.00 on one road. Abbey is from Albion to the Turnpike bridge.

NEW BUSINESS

2021 Fuel Purchase

Mayor states that it's just a second year of a contract that we signed, it is still the lowest and best price we have got, we just want to pick up the renewal.
