

STORM WATER COMMITTEE MINUTES
APRIL 6, 2021

The Storm Water Committee meeting was held on April 6, 2021 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:20 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. **Storm Water/Infrastructure Maintenance Monthly Report**

2. **Maintenance Projects**

Mr. Haselton stated there is one project he is aware of that the Soil and Water Conservation District is working with St. Matthew Church on the maintenance of their basin; so, they are getting that cleaned up and will be done within the next month. Ms. Fenos asked what they are doing. Mr. Haselton stated they are cleaning out sediment, some longer grass; cleaning it up.

Ms. Fenos asked if we have any other ongoing maintenance projects around the city. Mayor Antoskiewicz stated yes, we were on York Road yesterday finishing up near a piece of property the City is looking to purchase. The property owners had a small hole in their apron and the way the water comes in; they were going to add a catch basin. They actually found another catch basin over by the headwall and that's where a lot of deterioration was because the water had no way of going in so it was going underneath the culvert. They found that basin and also repairing the culvert.

Ms. Fenos asked if we are ready for all of the rain. She has received a lot of calls and emails already just in preparation for the springtime. She keeps trying to reassure people that the crews are out, they are being maintained and cleaning up. (was there a response?)

3. **Turnpike Mitigation**

Mr. Haselton stated he has been in contact with ODOT; clarifying the scope that had been set forth many years ago. He has not heard back yet. We have an aerial image of areas that we want to fix, but he wants to get their confirmation that that is what they are thinking as well.

4. **York Road Property**

Mayor Antoskiewicz stated that Ms. Vozar is still working on it. Ms. Fenos asked at what point would it go forward. Mr. Kelly stated he did speak with Ms. Vozar about this and she told him that while it was very difficult to secure, she believes now that she has the names of all of the owners and we have sent out letters to them advising them of our interest in making a purchase. We wish to see whether or not they want to engage in any negotiations. There are quite a few of them and we don't know what kind of success we have going this route, but we at least wanted to explore it to begin with. We may have something for you at the next meeting or next month.

NEW BUSINESS

1. **Proposed Ordinance – Bennett Road Manhole, Cath Basin, and Concrete Repair Project**

Mr. Smith stated we had a bid opening last week and Set In Stone was the lowest bidder on the job. He submitted a letter of recommendation to Council for the Wastewater Plant to award them the bid.

Mr. Weimer stated he wanted to thank Mr. Smith and the Mayor personally on behalf of Ward 5. That's an area that the Mayor and I walked a few years ago and talked to residents. We heard a lot about the manhole covers and the sinking that was occurring with them. He is excited to see us get those repaired the way that they should've been repaired so we can enjoy the investment that we made on Bennett Road and those residents can enjoy some peace and quiet as vehicles pass through that neighborhood.

Mr. Smith stated if that gets approved this evening by Council then we can go ahead and issue a notice of award and a letter to proceed so we can get started.

Mr. Weimer asked if a test was done in the fall. Mr. Smith stated we did a pilot program on a few of them just to see where the problem was. Then we know what we are dealing with. Mr. Weimer stated then we used the results of that and put the bid out.
