Mr. Piskura stated the reason he is here this evening is to give his opinion on the Flock camera system. He would like to make it clear that he is 100% for it. He stated that he spent 32 years with University Circle Police Department. The last 4 years he stated that they had LPR's (license plate readers) and as a shift supervisor, the cameras helped quite a bit; especially the cameras that are on Euclid Avenue coming west bound because we picked a lot of stuff out of east Cleveland. If nothing else, it gave an alert that people might be causing problems. He stated he has no complaints about them at all, for them, but the only thing he was wondering was how the city came up with the number of cameras. He believes they will do good here, especially on the major roads. A good example was last night there was an abduction in North Royalton. Something like that; get it into the system and everyone in the community is going to know to be on look out for that car.
