MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Antoskiewicz stated that he has some exciting news this evening. The City of North Royalton is going to partner with the North Royalton City School District to turn a portion of Royalview Elementary into a new Senior Center. Mayor Antoskiewicz stated this opportunity was born from a suggestion made by Ward 1 Councilman, John Nickell. He stated he and Mr. Nickell were speaking and Mr. Nickell stated he knew the Schools were looking to do some things with Royalview, but that he wasn't sure they would be able to utilize all of the space. Mayor Antoskiewicz stated he made a phone call to NRCS Superintendent Mike Laub inquiring about this proposal and Mr. Laub came back with much enthusiasm. Mayor stated, again, this is another example of the City and the school district working together for the betterment of the residents. Mayor stated that for a number of years he has heard seniors continually ask for a better senior

center facility. He listened and this is the answer to their needs. It is also another shining example of the great working relationship that we've enjoyed a number of years with the school district. Mayor Antoskiewicz stated he believes this is prudent use of tax dollars and is an efficient utilization of available space for the benefit and employment of our seniors. There will be some renovations that will need to be performed to a portion of the building before moving. The goal is to have this in place and ready to move in by the 1st of the year (2023). Mayor Antoskiewicz stated he believes this a better way to provide services to our seniors and address their needs, while still being fiscally responsible and cognizant of tax payer dollars.

Superintendent Laub stated that he has been with the district for about 9-10 months now and has had many great conversations with the City about things that can be done to partner as two prominent entities in the community that represent tax payers. Anytime that we are able to share and use things that tax payers have already paid for, it's a good opportunity to continue to do great things for them. He stated he is thankful and looks forward to the partnership in this realm but also is looking forward to the other things that will continue to go down the road to try and figure out what to do to maximize tax payer dollars and do great things for our community.
