Mr. McDonald stated he'd like to remind all of the committee members that in order to close their meeting, they should; under Robert's Rules, they need to have a motion made, a second and a vote.

The other issue he would like to bring up is the Memorial Park Pond with its drainage. He believes he can design something that would keep all of the birds out. He would like to remind everyone that this is to do the right thing. The Migratory Bird Act of 1819 (*should read 1918*) makes it illegal to poison, shoot, trap, harm or kill Canadian Geese and tamper with their eggs nest in the United States without permission from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. (*inaudible*) the fine is 6 months in jail, however if it determined that the person is aware, it is a felony and it carries a fine and up to 2 years in jail. He would encourage Council to do the right thing and come up with a proper drainage thing. It is not very difficult to do.
