

STORM WATER COMMITTEE MINUTES NOVEMBER 1, 2022

The Storm Water Committee meeting was held on November 1, 2022 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:24 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Storm Water/Infrastructure Maintenance Monthly Report

Mr. Smith advised that he included completed job requests in his report that had been e-mailed to everyone. Mr. Vos expressed his appreciation for all of the jobs completed, which included many in Ward 6. He received good feedback from residents.

2. Maintenance Projects

Mr. Haselton discussed the Sewer District Project at Thornhurst and Sprague Rd., whereas they were held up because they encountered a waterline that they were not expecting. There is a supply issue with the 12-inch water main that is needed. They do not feel that the project will begin construction until Spring of 2023.

3. Turnpike Mitigation

Ms. Haselton summarized that we are still making progress on the design. Everything is on schedule. ODOT (Ohio Department of Transportation) does not have this project scheduled for construction until 2024.

4. York Road Property

Mr. Kelly indicated that we are waiting on an answer to be filed by one particular defendant. If we do not have the answer filed by November 14th, we will file a motion to default. If the answer is filed, then we expect to have a hearing some time at the pleasure of the appropriate court.

5. Cleaning the Mains

Mr. Smith reported that we are still going to be in the Patricia and Gardenside Drive area. We have been doing some other storm water work, before we get into the bad weather. Ms. Barath inquired about cleaning leaves and the catch basins. There have been quite a few and she was wondering how it is handled. She was curious if there is going to be another wave of cleaning; knowing that trucks are getting prepared for snow. Mr. Smith indicated that we try to work hand in hand with Service. The street sweeper can handle that, however, if we get complaints about any drains, he encouraged to make them aware and it will be taken care of; on an as needed basis.
