

**STORM WATER COMMITTEE MINUTES  
JANUARY 3, 2023**

The Storm Water Committee meeting was held on November 1, 2022 at North Royalton City Hall, 14600 State Road. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**1. Storm Water/Infrastructure Maintenance Monthly Report**

Mr. Smith expressed his appreciation to Ms. Barath for her generosity, on behalf of his staff, around Christmas time.

**2. Maintenance Projects**

Mr. Haselton provided an update on the erosion behind the homes on Royalton Road. He has been in contact with the contractor who is performing maintenance on the basins at Dover Farms Apartments. They made a lot of progress toward the end of last year; they have a little more to go and may have to wait until spring time. We submitted a grant, Hazard Mitigation Grant, through FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency) for that project; the erosion problem. We will find out if it has been successful in the near future.

**3. Turnpike Mitigation**

Mr. Haselton reported that the final plans were submitted to ODOT (Ohio Department of Transportation) in December. Those are being reviewed. Construction is still not scheduled until next year.

**4. York Road Property**

Mr. Kelly advised that he, along with Ms. Vozar, participated in the first pre-trial on this case, which is now a year old. We did the prep work in 2020 and filed in 2021. Today was the first pre-trial, which was attended by two other lawyers, and one of the pro se defendants representing nearly all of the heirs. He continued that we are preparing at the court's instruction. We are going to prepare an agreed entry to fix, by agreement, the value of the property at the appraised figure. We are hopeful that everyone will join. Only one defendant was not represented, Geraldine Key. Mrs. Key, who is in her nineties, resides in Florida. Her son had represented her, who was an attorney in Chicago. However, he has passed away. Not only have all of the first-generation heirs passed on, most of the second generation have died as well; some of the third generation are also. We are hoping to get this resolved as soon as possible. There was one other lawyer who was representing Mrs. Key, that apparently did not get notice. We are hoping to agree that the value of the property is what our appraisers says that it is; that will not resolve the case. If everyone can agree on the value, we will be permitted to put the money in escrow with the Clerk, and we will get the deed rather promptly. Mr. Kelly indicated that he can report back in perhaps sixty to ninety days; based on the time frame that the court provided today.

Mayor Antoskiewicz commented, that is about as positive as it has been thus far. Mr. Kelly agreed and stated that it would depend on the last lawyer representing Mrs. Key, and whether or not they are agreeable to the appraised figure.

#### **5. Cleaning the Mains**

Mr. Smith indicated we would pick this up again once the weather improves around March or April; as previously stated. They are done now on an as needed basis. Ms. Barath noted positively that we have not heard of any problems.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

There was none.

#### **ADJOURNMENT**

Moved by Ms. Barath, seconded by Mr. Nickell to adjourn the **January 3, 2023 meeting**. Yeas: 2; Nays: 0.
