AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-50 AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT FOR DONATIONS/FUNDS FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON CITY SPONSORED EVENTS BY SPECIFYING TWO ADDITIONAL CITY SPONSORED EVENTS, THE SOLAR ECLIPSE BASH, AND THE TOUCH-A-TRUCK POLICE NIGHT OUT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton sponsors certain city events; and
- WHEREAS: Council has provided funds for the support of those events; and
- WHEREAS: Council approved Ordinance 22-50 authorizing the receipt for donations/funds for the North Royalton city sponsored events; and
- WHEREAS: It is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-50 by specifying an additional city sponsored events known as The Solar Eclipse Bash; and
- WHEREAS: It is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-50 by specifying an additional city sponsored events known as Touch-a-Truck Police Night Out; and
- WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance 22-50 to receive any and all donations to the specific city sponsored events known as: North Royalton Easter Parade, Parkapalooza, Movie Nights, Fishing Derby, Car Show, Harvest Fest, Halloween Madness, Holiday Lighting and Community Festival fireworks display, Solar Eclipse Bash, Touch-a-Truck Police Night Out, and directs the Mayor to adopt such reasonable restrictions for the use of those funds as may be reasonable and/or required by law.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is necessary to amend Ordinance 22-50 to specify an additional city sponsored event to authorize receipt of these donations/funds.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take affect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PORTS PETROLEUM FOR THE PURCHASE OF FUEL  
FOR THE 2024 SEASON AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton is authorized to purchase fuel through its membership in the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium (JMIC) which generally occurs at a lower rate than if purchased on the open market; and

WHEREAS: The JMIC follows competitive bidding requirements as set forth in the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS: The bids submitted to the JMIC were obtained in compliance with the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and Charter of the City of North Royalton.

WHEREAS: Council wishes to accept the contract price of Ports Petroleum for fuel for the 2024 season; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON,  
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The bid of Ports Petroleum, obtained through the Joint Municipal Improvement Consortium, for fuel to be supplied for 2024 to the City of North Royalton for Unleaded 87 Octane (transport) and ULS #2 Diesel (transport), with the option of renewal for year 2025, as set forth in Exhibit A, and which is in accordance with the specifications on file in the Office of the Director of Public Service and Properties, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of North Royalton with Ports Petroleum which shall be in accordance with the bid and specifications as set forth in Section 1 hereof, said contract to be in such form as is approved by the Director of Law.

Section 3. The Director of Public Service and Properties is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Ports Petroleum and all certified checks and bonds are hereby authorized to be returned to the unsuccessful bidders.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of fuel.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**RE:** 2024 Fuel Bid Recommendation

Please find attached bid tabulation from the Consortium bid opening on November 3, 2023 for the 2024-2025 Fuel Bid Program.

The City of North Royalton purchases Unleaded 87 Octane and ULS #2 Diesel via Transport delivery. Our underground fuel storage tanks capacity is 8,000 gallons for each fuel type. When ordering fuel, a combined minimum of 7,500 gallons between Unleaded and Diesel must be ordered.

As highlighted on the bid tabulation, Petroleum Traders submitted the lowest price differential for Unleaded 87. The savings will equate to .0176 per gallon, or approximately \$79.20 on our standard order of 4,500 gallons for Unleaded 87.

Even though the price per gallon for both fuel types will vary throughout the term of this agreement, entering into an agreement with a single supplier would prove to be a more efficient ordering process.

Therefore, I am recommending the City of North Royalton accept the bid of Ports Petroleum as the lowest and best bid for the 2024 year with option of renewal for year 2025.
