PUBLIC HEARING LEGAL NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 1264.05 of the City of North Royalton Zoning Code, **Notice** is hereby given that the **Board of Zoning Appeals** of the City of North Royalton, Ohio, will hold a public hearing on Thursday, **April 27**, **2023** at 7:00 p.m. local time in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 14600 State Road.

The Public Hearing will be heard on the question of granting of variances to **Chapter 1270 "Residential Districts"**, of the City of North Royalton Zoning Code. Request is being made by Wayne Chapman and Kathy Dobrowolski for a residential garage addition at 6181 Padua Drive North, also known as PPN: 488-01-055, in Residential R1-B District zoning. The variances being requested are as follows:

- Variance #1: Codified Ordinance Section 1270.05 "Schedule of Area, Yard, and Height Regulations." Code requires an 8-foot side yard setback in the R1-B district. Request is for a variance of 3 feet in order to construct an attached garage addition 5 feet from the property line.
- Variance #2: Codified Ordinance Section 1270.07 "Required Yards to be Maintained." Code states that a yard shall not be reduced to less than the required dimensions for the district in which it is located by enlarging an existing building. Request is for a variance to reduce the required 8-foot side yard by 3 feet for an attached garage addition.
- Variance #3: Codified Ordinance Section 1270.12(a) "Size, Location, Setbacks, and Height for Accessory Buildings and Private Garages." Code permits properties with a dwelling under 1800 square feet in size to have up to 800 square feet for an attached or detached private garage. Applicant is requesting a variance of 256 square feet in order to construct a 528 square foot garage addition to the existing 528 square foot garage for a total of 1,056 square feet.

Hearings for each variance will be taken in order as set forth in agenda. Hearings generally take approximately ten (10) minutes. All applicants and anyone wishing to be heard on a variance request should be present at the start of the meeting. Plans and specifications and other documentation are on file at the Building Division, City of North Royalton Service Center, 11545 Royalton Road, for review by interested parties.
