

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 18-44

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PART OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE OF THE CITY; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed its annual updating of the Planning and Zoning Code of the City; and

WHEREAS: Various ordinances of a general and permanent nature that have been passed by Council since the date of the last updating of the Planning and Zoning Code (August 1, 2016) have been included in the Planning and Zoning Code of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as part of the Planning and Zoning Code, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Planning and Zoning Code:

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of North Royalton, and for the further reason that it is necessary to have an up-to-date codification of the zoning laws of the City, to avoid practical and legal entanglements.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
