AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FIREFIGHTER EXPOSURE TO ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,065.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THE APPROVED EQUIPMENT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,078.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$10,065.00 from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant Program; and

WHEREAS: This grant award has been approved by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Safety Intervention Grant Program to be applied towards the purchase of 66 FireDex H-41 Particulate Blocking Firefighter Hoods and 66 pairs of Dragonfire Alpha-X Structural Firefighting Gloves; and

WHEREAS: The city's portion of this purchase is \$2,013.00 for a total purchase price of \$12,078.00; and

WHEREAS: It is therefore necessary to authorize the Mayor to accept the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant Program and to authorize the purchase of the approved equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant Program in the amount of \$10,065.00 and to authorize the purchase of 66 FireDex H-41 Particulate Blocking Firefighter Hoods and 66 pairs of Dragonfire Alpha-X Structural Firefighting Gloves pursuant to terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The city's portion of this purchase is \$2,013.00 for a total purchase price of \$12,078.00.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor to accept the grant award from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant Program as outlined above.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
