AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A FIVE YEAR LEASE AGREEMENT WITH FIFTH THIRD BANK FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOTOROLA RADIOS AND CONSOLE UNIT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$442,741.53 FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Council has authorized the purchase of radios and console unit for the North Royalton Police WHEREAS:

Department; and

The city is purchasing this equipment through Motorola Solutions and said purchase meets or WHEREAS:

exceeds the specifications of the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of

Administrative Services, as required by House Bill 204; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to provide for the funding of said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a five year lease agreement with Fifth Third Bank for the purchase of Motorola Radios and Console Unit for an amount not to exceed \$442,741.53 for the North Royalton Police Department from Motorola Solutions, 500 W. Monroe Street, Chicago, IL. 60661 as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten and pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law.

Section 2. This purchase meets or exceeds the specifications of the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services, as required by House Bill 204.

Section 3. The Police Department is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Motorola Solutions.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of this equipment for the North Royalton Police Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
