

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO 19-33

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL OF EVOQUA WATER TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE INTERNAL LIFT SCREW PUMP RETROFIT PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$121,625, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS: Evoqua Water Technologies is the manufacturer of the screw pumps that were recently installed at WWTP B; and
- WHEREAS: The city has experienced significant problems in the operation of the screw pumps, the source of which has not yet been fully determined, but the need for the retrofit has clearly been proven to be necessary; and
- WHEREAS: It was determined that the manufacturer should be in charge of the retrofit of these pumps; and
- WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Mayor to accept the proposal of Evoqua Water Technologies for the Internal Lift Screw Pump Retrofit project for an amount not to exceed \$121,625.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the proposal of Evoqua Water Technologies for the Internal Lift Screw Pump Retrofit project for an amount not to exceed \$121,625, pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Wastewater Superintendent is hereby authorized to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to Evoqua Water Technologies.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to accept the proposal of Evoqua Water Technologies for the Internal Lift Screw Pump Retrofit project so that this work may commence.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
