AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A STANDARD HIGHWAY EASEMENT TO CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO
FOR THE RT. 82 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PPN'S 483-20-030 (15 T) AND 486-20-009 (17 T),
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton desires to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga County, Ohio for the granting of a standard highway easement for the Rt. 82 Improvement project, PPN's 483-20-030 (15 T) and 486-20-009 (17 T); and

WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the granting of this easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Cuyahoga County, Ohio for the granting of a standard highway easement for the Rt. 82 Improvement project PPN's 483-20-030 (15 T) and 486-20-009 (17 T), pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Law Department shall take all steps necessary to record the easement at city expense.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary grant this easement so that work on the Rt. 82 Improvement project can commence.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
