AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF FABRIZI TRUCKING & PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE ROYALTON ROAD WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT (STATE ROAD TO PRINCE CHARLES DRIVE) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$689,513.04 AS THE LOWEST AND BEST BID, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has advertised for bids for the Royalton Road Water Main Replacement project; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that the bid of Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$689,513.04 is the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to accept this bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby accepts the bid of Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company, Inc. for the Royalton Road Water Main Replacement project for an amount not to exceed \$689,513.04 as the lowest and best bid, and authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company, Inc. and all certified checks and bonds are hereby authorized to be returned to the unsuccessful bidders.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to accept the bid of Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company, Inc. for the Royalton Road Water Main Replacement project so that this work may commence.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
