AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ENERGY CONSERVATION PROJECT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton agreed to enter into an energy conservation report pursuant to Section 717.02 of the Revised Code in Ordinance 18-123; and
- WHEREAS: The city entered into a performance contract with Leopardo to implement the recommended energy savings upgrades on said report in Ordinance 19-24; and
- WHEREAS: The city approved the sale of bonds in an amount not to exceed \$2,911,000 aggregate principal to pay for the recommended upgrades on the energy performance contract in Ordinance 19-39; and
- WHEREAS: Council wishes to establish a fund to account for the energy conservation project expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby directs the Director of Finance to create a fund in the financial records of the City of North Royalton as set forth below to account for the energy conservation project expenditures as required by the by-laws of the entity and the best practices of the Ohio State Auditor:

FUND 463 ENERGY CONSERVATION CAPITAL PROJECT FUND

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to create a fund within the financial records of the City of North Royalton to account for all finance activity for the energy conservation project expenditures, as required by the by-laws of the entity and the best practices of the Ohio State Auditor.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
