AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND WASTEWATER SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES, INC. FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT "A" TERTIARY FILTERS AND UV DISINFECTION REPLACEMENT PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$185,000.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The City of North Royalton has determined that professional engineering services are necessary during the construction of the Wastewater Treatment Plant "A" Tertiary Filters and UV Disinfection Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS: Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. has agreed to provide these professional engineering services for an amount not to exceed \$185,000.00; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to authorize the Mayor and Wastewater Superintendent to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to provide these engineering services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and Wastewater Superintendent to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to provide engineering services for the Wastewater Treatment Plant "A" Tertiary Filters and UV Disinfection Replacement Project for an amount not to exceed \$185,000.00 pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Wastewater Superintendent is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Mayor and Wastewater Superintendent to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to provide engineering services for the Wastewater Treatment Plant "A" Tertiary Filters and UV Disinfection Replacement Project.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
