ORDINANCE NO. 19-106

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-103, STAFFING AND CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, BY REPEALING ORDINANCE 19-102, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council is desirous of providing the most efficient services possible to the residents of the City of North Royalton, Ohio; and

WHEREAS: It has been determined that an amended personnel staffing and classification plan for the Mayor's Office of the City of North Royalton will aid in their administration and efficiency within the department; and

WHEREAS: Council has reviewed the staffing and classification plan and do desire to amend Ordinance 10-103, Staffing and Classification Plan for the various departments of the City of North Royalton, by repealing Ordinance 19-102 to correct a scrivener's error.

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance 10-103, Staffing and Classification Plan for the various departments of the City of North Royalton, by repealing Ordinance 19-102 to correct a scrivener's error.

Section 3. Ordinance 10-103 is hereby amended as provided for herein by repealing Ordinance 19-102 and that all other provisions of Ordinance 10-103 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to correct this scrivener's error.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
