AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 08-89 AND AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON BY REPEALING CHAPTER 238, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, REINSTATING CHAPTER 230 MAYOR, SECTION 230.06 MAYOR AS THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 08-90 PROVIDING SALARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council desires to eliminate the position of Director of Public Safety in the City of North Royalton; and

WHEREAS: Council has determined that the duties and responsibilities of the Director of Public Safety should be performed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS: Council therefore desires to repeal Ordinance 08-89 and amend the Codified Ordinances by repealing Chapter 238, Department of Public Safety wherein the position of Director of Public Safety is established and reinstating Chapter 230 Mayor, Section 230.06 Mayor as the Director of Public Safety and repeal Ordinance 08-90 providing salary appropriations for the position of Director of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to provide for these amendments, effective February 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby repeals Ordinance 08-89 and amends the Codified Ordinances of the City of North Royalton by repealing Chapter 238, Department of Public Safety by eliminating the position of Director of Public Safety, reinstating Chapter 230 Mayor, Section 230.06 Mayor as the Director of Public Safety; and repeal Ordinance 08-90, providing salary appropriations for this position, effective February 1, 2020.

Section 2. Pursuant to the Charter of the City of North Royalton, the Codified Ordinances and the applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, the power, authority and responsibility of the Director of Public Safety is vested in the Mayor.

Section 3. Any and all duties, powers, authority and responsibilities vested in the Director of Public Safety in the Codified Ordinances or Zoning ordinance is hereby vested in the Mayor.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary and timely to abolish the position of Director of Public Safety to ensure the proper execution of the duties and powers now vested in the Mayor.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
