

# THE CITY COUNCIL OF NORTH ROYALTON, OHIO

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CITY ENGINEER AND WASTEWATER SUPERINTENDENT TO TAKE SUCH ACTION AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO APPLY TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR PERMISSION TO CONVERT WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT B INTO A PUMPING STATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The North Royalton Consolidated Sewer District operates two wastewater treatment plants, “A” and “B”; and

WHEREAS: “B” Plant is aging and may need significant and expensive repairs and upgrades within the next three to five years; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to explore all possible avenues to serve the public and to do so in the most efficient and economical manner; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to explore the potential of converting B Plant into a pumping station for the potential cost savings that would be derived therefrom; and

WHEREAS: Any action to make such a conversion must begin with preliminary approval from the EPA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Council of the City of North Royalton does hereby authorize the Mayor, City Engineer and Wastewater Superintendent to inquire, seek and apply to the EPA for permission to convert B Plant into a pumping station and such other modifications as may be required to effect such a change.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of a majority of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
