AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 21-04, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CT CONSULTANTS, INC., AS CONSULTING ENGINEER TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON BY EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT AN ADDITIONAL 30 DAYS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: In order to conclude negotiations on an agreement for continuing services, the parties require some additional time; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to extend said agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 21-04 authorizing the Mayor to execute a contract with CT Consultants Inc., naming said organization as the Consulting Engineer of the City for the purpose of providing consulting engineering services to the city by extending the agreement an additional 30 days pursuant to terms and conditions approved by the Director of Law and substantially similar to a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall supersede all previously adopted ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to maintain professional engineering services to the city.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
