ORDINANCE NO. 21-121

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING FOR PUBLIC DEDICATION APPROXIMATELY 2,447 LINEAR FEET OF SANITARY SEWER LINE ALONG STATE ROAD AND EDGERTON ROAD SERVING THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED NORTH ROYALTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND ADJACENT PROPERTIES FROM THE NORTH ROYALTON BOARD OF EDUCATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: There has been submitted to Council a plan that sets forth for public dedication by the city approximately 2,447 linear feet of sanitary sewer line along State Road and Edgerton Road serving the newly constructed North Royalton Elementary School and adjacent properties (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS: The City Engineer has reported to Council that this instrument is sufficient to properly accept dedication this sewer line for public use and Council desires to approve said plan and accept the sewer line for dedication.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The dedication plan for approximately 2,447 linear feet of sanitary sewer line along State Road and Edgerton Road serving the newly constructed North Royalton Elementary School and adjacent properties as approved by the City Engineer is hereby accepted as dedicated to public use and owned by and now and hereafter the responsibility of the City of North Royalton.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the prompt dedication of the aforementioned sewer line to serve the elementary school and adjacent property owners.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
