AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE TERMINATION OF THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON AND GREAT LAKES RECYCLING, INC., DBA SIMPLE RECYCLING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SEND NOTICE OF TERMINATION TO GREAT LAKES RECYCLING, INC. DBA SIMPLE RECYCLING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The contractor providing recycling services to the city has failed to meet its' obligations under the existing agreement; and

WHEREAS: The agreement provides that the City shall have the sole right to terminate said agreement at any time, for any reason provided the City shall provide written notice of the termination six (6) months prior to the termination date; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to terminate the agreement and authorize the Mayor to take such measures as may be required to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to terminate the agreement with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. dba Simple Recycling and to take such action as may be required to effect that termination.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to terminate said agreement with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. dba Simple Recycling due to failing to meet its' obligations under the existing agreement.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
