RESOLUTION NO. 22-20

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY THE QUESTION OF THE REPLACEMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY OF A 1.7 MILL TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: This Council, on January 18, 2022, adopted a resolution declaring it to be necessary to provide for the replacement in its entirety of the existing additional tax of 1.7 mills in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing emergency medical service which such authority to levy such additional tax expiring with the levy made on the 2021 tax list and duplicate, to be collected in 2022 (the “Existing Levy”), in order to receive sufficient revenues and to continue to receive revenues therefrom without interruption (the “Resolution of Necessity”) and requested the County Fiscal Officer to provide the necessary certifications under 5705.03 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS: the County Fiscal Officer has certified that the amount that would be produced by a levy of 1.7 mills would be \$1,821,994, and the total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$1,071,761,400 (the “Fiscal Officer’s Certification”); and

WHEREAS: this Council has determined to proceed with the levy described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. This Council hereby determines to proceed with the submission of the question of the replacement in its entirety of the Existing Levy of 1.7 mills for the purpose of providing emergency medical service for a period of five years at the same rate as the Existing Levy (being 1.7 mills for each one dollar in tax valuation), beginning with the tax list and duplicate for the year 2022, the proceeds of which levy first would be distributed to this City in the calendar year 2023, and such question shall be submitted pursuant to the Resolution of Necessity and this Resolution adopted under Article XIV of the City Charter and Sections 5705.192, 5705.19(U) and 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code to the electors of the City of North Royalton at the election to be held therein on May 3, 2022, as authorized by law. That election shall be held at the regular places of voting in the City as established by the Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, or otherwise, within the times provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

Section 2. The Director of Legislative Services, in her capacity as Clerk of Council, is hereby authorized and directed to give or cause to be given notice of said election as provided by law.

Section 3. The Director of Legislative Services, in her capacity as Clerk of Council, is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution, the Resolution of Necessity and the Fiscal Officer’s Certification to the Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, no later than February 2, 2022.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Resolution is required to be immediately effective so that it can be timely filed with the Board of Elections in order to submit the tax levy to the electors at the election stated in Section 1.

THEREFORE, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
