AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) CATERPILLAR MODEL 299D3 COMPACT TRACK LOADER FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON SERVICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH SOURCEWELL, FORMERLY NJPA, COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, VENDOR OHIO CAT, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$86,982.88, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has determined the need to purchase one (1) Caterpillar Model 299D3 compact track loader for the North Royalton Service Department; and

WHEREAS: The city is purchasing this equipment through Sourcewell, formerly NJPA, Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS: It is necessary to provide for the funding of said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$86,982.88 for the purchase of one (1) Caterpillar Model 299D3 compact track loader for the North Royalton Service Department pursuant to Contract No. 032119-CAT through Sourcewell, formerly NJPA, Cooperative Purchasing Program, Vendor: Ohio CAT, 3993 E. Royalton Road, Broadview Heights, Ohio 44147, Vendor #213816 and as further described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. The Service Director is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to Sourcewell, formerly NJPA, Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the purchase of this equipment for the North Royalton Service Department for the proper and immediate performance of departmental duties.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
