AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 21-94 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE ONE (1) 2021 CHEVROLET SILVERADO 2500HD 4 WD CREW CAB WORK TRUCK FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$34,352.00 FOR THE NORTH ROYALTON FIRE DEPARTMENT, VENDOR TIM LALLY CHEVROLET, BY INCREASING THE NOT TO EXCEED COST BY AN ADDITIONAL \$331.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: Council has authorized the purchase of a vehicle for the North Royalton Fire Department through Tim Lally Chevrolet for an amount not to exceed \$34,352.00; and

WHEREAS: After review and inspection of the vehicle to be purchased, it has been determined to be necessary to include additional items and equipment to this vehicle; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to amend Ordinance 21-94 to reflect the increase in cost of \$331.00, and establish a new not to exceed cost of \$34,683.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 21-94 is hereby amended to allow for additional items and equipment in the amount of \$331.00 and establish a new not to exceed cost of \$34,683.00, as further outlined in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. Ordinance 21-94 is hereby amended as provided for herein and all other provisions of Ordinance 18-48 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to amend Ordinance 21-94 in order to allow for additional items and equipment.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
