AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF DAVE SMEREK TO SERVE AS INTERIM BUILDING COMMISSIONER FOR THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: The position of Interim Building Commission is an appointive position; and

WHEREAS: The Mayor has appointed Dave Smerek to the position of Interim Building Commissioner; and

WHEREAS: Council confirms the various appointments made by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS: Council desires to confirm this appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH ROYALTON, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby confirms the appointment of Dave Smerek to the position of Interim Building Commissioner, effective July 1, 2022, pursuant to the terms and conditions as approved by the Director of Law and Mayor.

Section 2. Said appointment shall be effective upon adoption of this Ordinance and shall terminate at such time as a successor has been appointed and confirmed.

Section 3. The Interim Building Commissioner shall receive such pay as the Building Commissioner as set forth in Ordinance 21-182.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the city, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the aforementioned appointment.

THEREFORE, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
